# Questions you may have, answered.

## **Will I have to take my exams?**

You will know that exams are cancelled, though you will still have assessments taking place throughout your remaining time in school so teachers are able to accurately assess your overall progress and level.

## **What does this mean about my grade?**

The school submits something called a Centre Assessed Grade (CAG), which means we collate a portfolio of evidence based on your performance and what you were on track to achieve in order to submit a fair and accurate grade that reflects your true ability.

## **I did badly in my mocks, will this count toward my grade?**

We will be using a variety of evidence, not just single mock grades. We will be taking into account assessments completed before your mocks, your mock grades and future assessment scores over the next few weeks. It's a whole picture of you that we submit, not just one exam score.

# Questions you may have, answered.

**What do I need to do now to get a good grade if we don't have 'real' exams?**

You will be sitting assessments in school to show your true capabilities.

You deserve an education, not just an exam grade. That is exactly what we intend to give you. It is so important that you engage in all of your learning. You may not be sitting external exams, but assessments will still take place in school that will be considered as part of your submitted grade. We want our assessment of you to be **accurate and fair**.

We want you to enjoy your last few months at school too, knowing that you have worked hard for over four years. We don't want any of this to go to waste or seem pointless, it is not!
